Temporary Regulation Certificate Environment Canterbury Navigation Safety Bylaws 2010 Part 7.2.1 (b) and (c)

Name of holder: Lake Hood Aquatic Park

Purpose: To ensure all powered vessels using the waters of Lake Hood are registered with Lake Hood Aquatic Park and are clearly identifiable using allocated identification numbers, and to empower Lake Hood Aquatic Park to prohibit use either temporarily or permanently of the Lake's waters by any power vessel which is not registered and/or not displaying the correct identification information. This is to provide Lake Hood Aquatic Park with better control of the vessels using the Lake to improve boating safety.

Regulation: To reserve the waters of Lake Hood for use by oared, paddle and sail craft and by only those powered vessels which have been registered with Lake Hood Aquatic Park and are displaying approved identification numbers.

- The identification numbers are to be the same number as the trailer registration of the trailer usually used to transport the vessel.
- Where two or more vessels are launched from or transported on the same trailer, the trailer registration number can be used on all those vessels.
- The identification number on the vessels are to be of adequate size and visibility to be read at distance, and placed on both sides of the vessel in positions where they can best be seen.
- The identification on the vessels shall be only of the size, type and design as Lake Hood Aquatic Park may from time to time decide.
- Lake Hood Aquatic Park and authorised officers shall have the power to refuse admission to the waters of the lake by vessels which are not registered and/or not displaying the allocated identification information.

Reserved Area: All of Lake Hood

Period: From 1 October 2013 until revoked or until incorporated into the Bylaws by a future review

Conditions:

- Notice of the intention to impose this requirement is to be publicly advertised in local media and on the Lake Hood website.
- A reasonable period shall be given for vessel owners to register their vessels and obtain the required identification numbers and fix them to their vessels.
- Permanent signs are to be placed at key locations at the Lake to advise vessel owners of this requirement and advising how they may go about registering and obtaining identification numbers.
